2026 Anthony J. MacKay Student Paper Contest

All students enrolled full-time in a Canadian college or university program related to the radiation sciences, as well as students who have graduated since May 2025, are eligible to enter. To enter, submit a max 750 word abstract on a topic that includes some aspect of radiation protection.

Three finalists will be chosen to present their paper in person at the CARST-CRPA Symposium on Radon and Radiation Protection in Saskatoon, SK from May 27-31, 2026.



The three finalists will receive complimentary conference registration (including banquet) and three nights' hotel accommodation to attend the conference and present their papers, be featured in the <u>CRPA Bulletin</u>, and their papers will be published in the Conference Program.



The winner will receive the Anthony J. MacKay Trophy and a \$500 cash prize. The award will be presented at the Symposium Banquet, and a feature article, along with their paper, will be published in the <a href="https://example.com/creativecom/cre



All contest entrants will receive a complimentary membership with <u>CRPA</u> and <u>CARST</u> (valid until December 31, 2026). Entrants who are already members will have their membership extended by one year.
